Orange Class - Spring Term 2008 Topics

I am writing to let you know the topics your children will be covering at School this term. Please ask me if you would like any further clarification of anything.

In Literacy, we will be looking at Traditional Tales, Labels, List and Captions and Information Tests. We will be continuing with our regular phonics, spelling and handwriting practice. For the moment, only the Panthers group need to learn spellings for the rainbow awards, and they will be tested on a Thursday.

Our Numeracy work will focus on developing children's understanding of ordinal numbers, place value, ordering, describing position and telling the time.

In Science, the children will be developing their investigative skills through learning about materials and their properties.

Our humanities topic will involve considering the different types of home people live in and comparing these with the homes that people had in Victorian times.
