Dear Parents/Carers,

'One kind word' has been the theme of our Anti-Bullying week. We value the importance of kindness, whether that's us being kind to people ourselves or receiving kindness from others. A national survey carried out by the charity Kidscape revealed three-quarters of children (74%) say pupils in school are kind to them and over 94% say they're kind to others. In Collective Worship, all the children have reflected on kind words and deeds they can say and do- even a smile or a please or thankyou can make someone's day. All pupils received a 'Keeping Safe' booklet, which reminds children of how school keeps them safe and how the adults support this. In a recent pupil voice governor monitoring visit, pupils across all classes were very clear that the staff are their trusted adults and they share worries and concerns with them. I am proud that the staff of Curry Rivel respond to concerns raised by the children in a timely way, often 'in the moment'. Sometimes 'issues' can be resolved quickly, and at other times, it takes a bit more time to resolve problems and fall-outs. When staff are dealing with more complex problems between friends and peers, we always work with you to keep you informed; I know as a parent myself, it is vital that we work together to support our children in being safe, happy and confident.

Of course, a big thank you for supporting Children in Need today- we are currently counting the monies raised!
