Sunday 6 May

United Benefice Rogation Sunday – This 'progressive service' with Reverend Scott will move from church to church as we re-vitalise the ancient practice of offering prayers for a fruitful harvest. Alongside this we shall also be 'beating the bounds' as we pass over parish boundaries, praying for God's protection for the land and those who farm it, but also for our churches and communities.

Plan:1) **Arrive for 9.15** at St Martin's Fivehead for bacon butties, coffee/tea etc. and a 10 minute opening service for prayer, event introduction, and a hymn.

- 2) **Depart by 9.45** on foot (via the back road) to Swell, short gathering at Fivehead/Swell parish boundary for prayers + hymn/song, pausing at Senga's home for a loo stop as necessary!
- 3) Arrive 10.35 at St. Catherine's Swell for a short Family Communion Service.
- 4) **Depart at around 11am** via the footpath heading towards Pitt Court beating the bounds moment as we enter the Curry Rivel Parish. After crossing the main road we resume the walk (again on footpaths) to St. Andrew's our final approach to the church being via Water Street.
- 5) **Arrive 12.30ish at St. Andrew's** for a final short gathering of thanks and praise where with our last energy we close with a rousing hymn, before joining together for a bring and share lunch in the Old School Room.

Food for the lunch can be delivered to the OSR in advance, 8.45–9am. Dog walkers most welcome throughout.
