A big thank you for all the lovely homework projects - all the children did extremely well at showing them to parents and other children in the school. It was lovely to see them engaging in conversations and sharing how they went about making their different creations.

Please note there is no forest school next half term, we would however appreciate keeping your child's wellies in school for wet playtimes.

During the week we have:

- Read the story of Little Red Riding Hood and used it to discuss following rules that grown-ups give us and the importance of not talking to strangers
- Recorded objects in Little Red Riding Hood's basket, using our segmenting and blending skills along with our recognition of letter sounds learnt so far
- Begun sounding out words/simple captions and matching them to their correct picture
- Used play dough to form CVC words, sounding and reading them aloud
- Recognised numerals to 20, counting out the correct amount of cakes into Little Red Riding Hood's basket
- Completed incomplete number lines where the Big Bad Wolf had eaten some of the numbers
- Completed a paint by numbers Little Red Riding Hood picture, looking to recognise numbers to 10 then 20
- Sequenced numbered Little Red Riding Hood numbers to 10 and 20
- Used an interactive whiteboard game to segment and blend real and nonsense words
- As part of PSED we have also discussed the rules around walking near roads and the importance of keeping ourselves safe
